Our School Counseling Program

Our School Counseling team will provide systemic support through multidimensional interventions, including 1:1 counseling to address social/emotional issues at school. School counselors provide individual, group, and classroom counseling sessions which are short term and solution-focused in a typical school year.

Tier 1 Services

<u>Success Bound</u> - 6th - 8th grade students will participate in weekly lessons to support their successful transition to high school and post secondary options.
